JUDGMENT IN A CIVIL CASE

Pursuant to the jury's verdict, dated March 30, 2007 (Doc. 110), it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

FINAL JUDGMENT is **ENTERED** in favor of Plaintiff Donna L. Reilly and against Defendant Duval County Public Schools as follows:

1. \$53,197.18 compensates plaintiff for lost wages and benefits for the 2003-2004 school year (recovered under the Age Discrimination in Employment Act ("ADEA") and the Florida Civil Rights Act ("FCRA"));
2. \$40,000.00 compensates plaintiff for lost wages and benefits for the 2004-2005 school year (recovered under the ADEA and FCRA);
3. \$40,000.00 compensates plaintiff for lost wages and benefits for the 2005-2006 school year (recovered under the ADEA and FCRA);
4. \$75,000.00 compensates plaintiff for mental anguish (recovered under the FCRA only);

5. \$15,443.52 in prejudgment interest on plaintiff's lost wages and benefits up through the date of the jury's verdict;
6. \$555.00 in per diem prejudgment interest spanning March 31, 2007 through the date of entry of the judgment; and
7. The total Judgment amount is \$224,195.70.

Defendant Duval County Public Schools shall pay post-judgment interest on Plaintiff's total recovery (\$224,195.70) commencing on the date of this Judgment until this Judgment is satisfied, as provided in 28 U.S.C. § 1961.

The Court reserves jurisdiction to determine Plaintiff's entitlement to a reasonable attorney's fee and recoverable costs.
